He worked at United California Bank in the credit card division in Van Nuys, California. He then moved to manage the Credit Card Division in Simi Valley, California, then moved to the Japan Credit Bank (JCB Inc.) and spent several years with this bank and integrated the two countries with the credit card business. He traveled extensively during his career with JCB.
